The new "Crossroad Bar & Bistro" at the Sheraton Luxembourg Aerogolf Hotel

Following the complete refurbishment of its 148 guest rooms in 2003, and the opening of the new restaurant "Signature" last December, the Sheraton Luxembourg Aerogolf Hotel now announces the opening of the completely renovated "Crossroad Bar & Bistro".

The "Crossroad" Bar & Bistro" was designed with reference to guest's feedback, in cooperation with the Senior Designer Tarek Hegazy of "Living Design AB" Sweden and using the professional experience of the whole Sheraton Luxembourg Team. The new "Crossroad Bar & Bistro" features a warm atmosphere, underlined by a red-brown-beige colour scheme, and using materials of high quality, such as natural mahogany wood and brushed stainless steel.

"The preferred meeting point is the long glass bar counter with LED-lighting underneath", admits Bar Manager Estelle Ziglio. Guests can taste the large range of cocktails, created by the Sheraton Luxembourg Bar Team, whilst sitting on one of 30 bar stools, upholstered in red leather with a high back.

The bistro area offers a capacity of up to 60 table seats, where guests are invited to sit back in the comfortable suede lounge chairs, while enjoying one of the innovative dishes, Executive Chef Hervé Ciufoletti and his team offer on the "Crossroad Bar & Bistro" – menu.

The cosy lounge areas are the perfect place to relax & enjoy. The fabrics of the sofas are decorated with striped velvets and a shimmering taffeta with decorative yarn, combined with a bouclé weave for a luxurious look. Grand easy arm chairs, in beige colour, contribute to the guests' comfort. The TV corner, broadcasting international channels, invites the guests to stay well informed. The live piano entertainment with Janos Nadasi is of course one of the special highlights in the evening.

The new "Crossroad Bar & Bistro" also serves as a compliment to the restaurant "Signature", offering new innovative light and healthy food; warm main courses, salads and sandwiches – pita bread, ciabatta, baguette and nordic bread. In summer time guests can enjoy the outside terrace, offering a capacity for 90 guests.

Additional to the "Crossroad Bar & Bistro" the Sheraton Luxembourg has created a new concept, the "Crossroad Take Away" – for people on the move: hot and cold drinks, sandwiches, fresh fruit salads, pastry & snacks. The "Take Away" counter is located at the entrance of the bar.

The designer wants to invite the bar guests to be comfortable, relaxed and happy. Tarek Hegazy selected carefully International artwork by Susan Gillette, Lazlo Emmerich, Guy Buffet and Bill Brauer as decoration for the "Crossroad Bar & Bistro". The paintings reflect a sense of creativity, stark imagery, earthy and strong colours, by exploring the sense of optimism and positivism at the same time.

The Sheraton is very security conscious and whilst sprinkler system installation is not mandatory in this country, the Sheraton Luxembourg has installed this system as well as new emergency exit signs and fire alarm in all new renovated areas.

The refurbishment of the new Front Desk area has been completed as well. The renovation of the new Business Centre and break out room "Schengen" is now in progress, with the Grand Opening scheduled for June 2005.
